- 7) the scanned photo&personal message pages of ID; and
- 8) the application form, which is appended in this announcement.

4 scholarship winners of ISFC 44 in 2017 will be selected and announced before 10 April 2017; and the flight tickets will be purchased by the HHIFUND and the itineraries will be sent to the honorees.
